


Alcenia's Restaurant Renovation

City of Memphis Municipal Complex 2

What makes the project stand out:

The City of Memphis purchased the Coca-Cola Bottling Company site in 2019. For 70 years the 18-acre property was the location of the former Coca-Cola offices, bottling plant, and warehouses. It is being converted to the new City of Memphis Municipal Complex 2. The site is centrally located and adjacent to the Iconic Liberty Bowl Stadium, the former Memphis Coliseum, and the new Memphis Sports and Events Center. An important goal of this multi-phased project is to adaptively reuse the buildings on the former Coca-Cola Site, revitalizing these buildings into productive and efficient new assets for The City and the surrounding community.
